Greetings,

The Town Council of Remington hereby announces the Town Meeting for our Virginia Department of Housing and Community Development (VDHCD), Community Development Block Grant application. In August, 2022, the Town of Remington requested a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for assistance for developing the town's Business District Revitalization (BDR) Project. On October 17, 2022, VHD sent a letter requiring initial activities occur prior to awarding the grant. For more information on the BDR, see: [www.remington-va.gov](http://www.remington-va.gov)

WHAT: According to the VDHCD letter, as part of the CDBG grant process:

"The town must schedule a public meeting to give citizens an overview of the proposed project. Citizens must be informed of the town's intentions to improve the business environment including, connectivity and pedestrian safety, as well as streetscape and façade improvements. Citizens must also be informed of potential future activities of the project, including additional public and project management team meetings and of the completion of physical design plans (for the streets and facades), business growth plans, and/or engineering assessments in the project area. The town must disclose that future Planning Grant and Community Improvement Grant (CIG) funding depends on completion of these initial activities. At this meeting, energized community leaders called "sparkplugs" must be identified and included as members of the management team."

An initial meeting was held on January 25, 2022, to discuss the grant application process and to welcome interested parties. Since then, The Management Team has been selected, including, but not limited to, the mayor, and two representatives from the Town Council.
